

CAINES CREEK POOL RULES

2021 Season – Opening July 3, 2021

Below are the pool rules that ALL residents of Caines Creek (including owners, children, tenants) must follow. Caines Creek Council reserves the right to update the pool rules.

EVERYONE ENTERING THE POOL AREA IS ASSUMED TO KNOW AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY THESE RULES.

1. **POOL HOURS: 9 AM – 9PM** - There is to be no swimming after **9:00 PM**.
2. **Owners that are in good standing and who signed a waiver on behalf of those residing at that address, are entitled to pool privileges. Until further notice, guests are NOT allowed.**
3. **As per the CDC guidelines, social distancing is required. No pool furniture will be put out this year. You may bring your own, but it must be removed when you leave for the day.**
4. **Masks are required when outside the pool if unvaccinated, optional for those vaccinated.**
5. Everyone **MUST** sign into the pool area upon entry. There will be a sign-in clipboard on the table immediately inside the entrance. This is **required** by the Chester County Health Department.
6. Small children should stay in the shallow end of the pool. **Children under 15 years of age MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult.** Children who are not potty trained may not swim without appropriate “Swimmers”-- NO DIAPERS allowed.
7. Any activity in or out of the pool, which may subject anyone including oneself to potential harm, is strictly prohibited.
8. No articles made of breakable glass (i.e. glasses, bottles, pitchers, etc.) are permitted in the pool area.
9. No rafts or tire tubes are allowed in the pool area.
10. Swimsuits are the only permissible attire; no cutoffs are allowed.
11. No pushing, pulling or throwing of anyone into the pool.
12. No eating, smoking, or consumption of alcoholic beverages in the pool area.
13. No running or diving in the pool area.
14. NO animals are permitted in the pool area.
15. **Use of restrooms will be permitted for residents only and masks are required.**
16. This is a family friendly environment. Appropriate language should be used at all times. Profanity will not be tolerated.
17. Any personal items left in pool area will be discarded at the end of each day.
18. Pool equipment to include the skimmer, flotation devices, shepherd’s hook, etc., should only be used by a responsible adult and for its intended use.

If you see violations of the above rules and feel uncomfortable addressing them with the violators, you can contact PENCO Management at 610-358-5580 during business hours. You will need to provide specifics regarding the violation to include the name or address of the violator.
